

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE U. T. LEVEL VIGILANCE & MONITORING COMMITTEE FOR RURAL DEVELOPMENT HELD UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF THE HON'BLE ADMINISTRATOR, IN THE CONFERENCE HALL, SECRETARIAT, DAMAN ON 26/12/2011 AT 4.00 P.M.

At the outset, the Chief Executive Officer, District Panchayat, Daman welcomed the Chairman/Hon'ble Administrator, Daman & Diu and Dadra Nagar Haveli, Shri Narendra Kumar and other members of the Committee. He informed that the last meeting was held on 26/09/2011. He explained that the objectives of this meeting is to review the progress under various Rural Development Schemes and discuss the various problems in implementing the schemes and the target fixed by the Rural Development Department. He explained the performance of various Rural Development programmes in the U. T. of Daman & Diu.

MGNREGA:


The Chief Executive Officer, District Panchayat informed that there is no scope of undertaking the scheme in Daman due to the reason that the disparity in wages being given under MGNREGA are lower than the minimum wages for the industrial workers in Daman & Diu. The Project Director, DRDA, Daman informed that the department has published the pamphlet in the Gujarati language and distributed among the Sarpanches, Gram Sevak, VP Secretaries through Block Development Officer, Daman / Diu to create the publicity in the Villages and spread awareness about MGNREGA. Shri Vishal Tandel, President, D&D T.C.C. suggested to include work performed by small and marginal farmers in their own fields to be eligible under the scheme. Shri Vasubhai Patel asked for a budget under the scheme for those GPs which want to implement this. The Hon'ble Administrator suggested to Chief Executive Officer, District Panchayat, Daman to discuss this matter in the meeting with Sarpanchs, Member of Village Panchayats and District Panchayat.

The Hon'ble Administrator directed Block Development Officer, Daman to prepare labour budget with the help of all Sarpanchs for undertaking MGNREGA scheme in Daman District. Also Hon'ble Administrator directed to obtain details from the Block Development Officer, Diu for an amount of Rs. 6.70 lakhs transferred in the month of June, 2011 for starting works under MGNREGA in Diu District. Further, Hon'ble Administrator directed to submit the Utilization Certificate for the year 2008-2009 and 2009-2010 to the Ministry.

INDIRA AWAS YOJANA :

The Project Director, DRDA informed that during the current financial year 2011-12, 31 cases under Indira Awas Yojna received in the previous year and 11 applications received in the current year have been sanctioned and the amount of Rs. 18,90,000/-



have been distributed to the beneficiaries by the B.D.O., Daman. An amount of Rs. 22.26 lakhs is available for this scheme during current year. The Hon'ble Administrator has directed Chief Executive Officer, District Panchayat to submit a proposal for inclusion in the 12th Five year Plan on the pattern of scheme approved in Dadra & Nagar Haveli namely "U. T. Indira Awas Yojna".

SGSY (SWARANJAYANTI GRAM SWAROZGAR YOJANA):

The Project Director, DRDA informed that the objective of the scheme is to assist poor families below the poverty line by ensuring appreciable, increase in income over a period of time. This objective is to be achieved by inter-alia organizing the rural poor into Self Help Group (SHGs) through a process of social mobilization, training and capacity building and providing income – generating assets through Bank credit and Government subsidy. During the current financial year target of 25 beneficiaries has been fixed. 16 applications have been received during the current year out of which 06 applications have already been submitted to the Bank and 10 applications are under process. The Hon'ble Administrator directed Block Development Officer, Daman to creat awarness among the people about this scheme in order to seek more applications i.e. approximately 50-75 to achieve the target.

PMGSY (PRADHAN MANTRI GRAM SADAK YOJNA)


The Technical Officer informed that the Ministry had released an amount of Rs. 500 lakhs during the year 2000-01 and Rs. 500 lakhs in the year 2006-07 against which an amount of Rs. 807.20 lakhs has been utilized up to the year 2008-09 and there is a saving of Rs. 192.80 lakhs. An amount of Rs. 169.75 lakhs is also available as accrued interest thereon. The Hon'ble Administrator directed to the Technical Officer, District Panchayat to make a plan to utilize the balance fund. It was informed by Technical Officer that the report from the consultant – agency pertaining to the proposed scheme is likely to be received soon and therefore the proposal is likely to begin.

The Hon'ble Administrator informed that this scheme will first be implemented at tourist places and if successful, the same will be implemented in Rural area also.


COMPUTERIZATION OF LAND RECORDS :

The Collector, Daman informed that the process of computerization of land records is under full sewing. Already the land records of previous year having around 43,000 entries have been computerized and the same are now being checked by Talathis. The Talathis will check all the entries by 15th January, 2012 and thereafter, Mamlatdar will validate all the entries within a period of 30 days. Once this legacy data is updated, then the regular entry will be regulated every day so that the public can get the latest land records through internet / information kiosk etc.

The Hon'ble Administrator desired that a meeting of President, District Panchayat, selected representatives of District Panchayat, Sarpanches of all Village Panchayats, President, D.M.C., and all concerned officers of various departments should be convened at the level of Development Commissioner on 28/12/2011 so that a comprehensive strategy for implementation of all development schemes, both Central and U. T. level could be adopted.
