

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD IN THE CHAMBER OF THE
COLLECTOR, COLLECTORATE, DAMAN ON 08.12.2012 AT 11.00 A.M. TO
DISCUSS THE VENUE FOR ORGANIZING LIBERATION DAY
CELEBRATION OF DAMAN & DIU ON 19TH DECEMBER, 2012.**

The meeting was chaired by Shri P. S. Reddy, Hon'ble Collector, Daman. the following officers/representatives who attended the meeting.

At the outset, the Collector, Daman welcomed the Political leader/Officers from the Administration and apprised all that the present to decide the Venue of the Liberation Day celebration, whether it should be Bandodkar Stadium or Govt. College Ground.

The Superintendent of Police, Daman stated that :-

1. The parking place for the vehicles is not sufficient to park vehicles in a proper manner at Bandodkar Stadium.
2. There is narrow space at the entrance gate of Bandodkar Stadium which may cause inconvenience to move or rush Fire Tender and Ambulance at the time of emergency in event of fire/ stampede/ mischief, it will extremely difficult to evacuate people and provide emergency services.
3. Bandodkar Stadium is situated in a heavily populated area and Bus Stand, Vegetable Market and Taxi Tempo stand are also present near the area, having high rise buildings surrounding the Bandodkar Stadium which may cause security issues.
4. There is not sufficient place for public seating at Bandodkar Stadium and it is difficult to seat the VIPs, Elected Representatives Officers, Freedom fighters and general Public.
5. Liberation Day Parade march past is not conducted properly due to short distance of Parade ground.

In the light of the aforementioned, they requested that the Venue of Liberation Day celebration may be fixed at Government College Ground, Nani Daman.

Shri Devjibhai J. Tandel, Ex. Member of Parliament present stated that the Venue could have been Bandodkar Stadium as it is situated in the middle of the town and it will be convenient for all to attend the function at Bandodkar Stadium. The Collector made known to him that the Administration will provide free Mini Bus service to transport the public from (1) Tin Batti, Nani Daman (2) Nani Daman Bus Stand and (3) Moti Daman Market to Govt. College Ground, Nani Daman and back, so that no inconvenience is caused to the general public regarding transportation. Shri Devjibhai J. Tandel stated that keeping in view the difficulties pointed out by the Police Department in celebrating the Liberation Day celebration at Bandodkar Stadium and also that free Bus Services is being made available by the Administration, he agreed to the suggestion of Liberation Day Celebration at Government College Ground, Nani Daman. It was unanimously decided to celebrate 19th December at College Ground.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.
