

C I R C U L A R

The New Year's celebrations in Daman attract large number of tourists. In order to maintain Law & Order and to facilitate the celebrations, the following instructions are issued for the compliance of various departments/offices.

1. The Sub Divisional Police Officer, Daman shall give special attention to traffic regulation/control, and Law and Order.
2. Proper security arrangements shall be made by Sub Divisional Police Officer in the entire district and especially at the thickly congregated/vulnerable areas like Devka, Jampore and Tin Batti etc.
3. The Executive Magistrates shall petrol the respective area and assist the police in maintaining Law & Order.
4. The Sub Divisional Police Officer shall open an assistance cell for the benefit of the tourists.
5. The Excise staff shall petrol the areas and check the Bars & Restaurants land sale of liquor outside premises.
6. The Deputy Director of Transport/R.T.O. Inspector shall also regulate the traffic and shall book the cases against the offenders who violate Motor Transport Act and Rules.
7. Director of Fire Service shall place fire tender at the Police Station to meet any emergency.
8. The Director of Medical & Health Services, Daman will keep ambulance and the other medical services available round the clock to deal with any emergency, both at PHC, Moti Daman and at Govt. Hospital, Marwad.
9. The Sub Divisional Magistrate, Daman shall coordinate the activities of Police, Executive Magistrates, Medical Services etc and Control Room from 6.00 p.m. on 31st December, 2013 to 3.00 a.m. on 1st January 2014.

NOTIFICATION


In exercise of the powers conferred upon me under Section 217, 115 & 117 of Motor Vehicle Act, 1988 and in consultation with the local public representatives and police authorities. I, **Ramesh Verma**, District Magistrate, Daman do hereby notify the following places as '**Restricted Zone**' for '**entry of vehicles**' "**No Parking**" and '**Parking Zone**' as mentioned below:-

Sr. No.	Place	Zone
1.	The road between Hotel Sandy resort, Devka and Govt. Hospital Marwad.	No parking, No halting of Vehicle will be allowed on either side, One way traffic from Govt. Hospital Marwad toward Sandy Resort onwards will be allowed. There is no restriction on pedestrian's Traffic.
2.	Open space behind Hotel Summer House, Nani Daman.	Vehicle parking Zone.
3.	Open space opposite OI DC Wine Shop, Devka, Nani Daman.	Vehicle Parking Zone.
4.	Open space near Govt. Middle School, Marwad, Devka Road, Nani Daman.	Vehicle Parking Zone.
5.	Open space opposite Hotel Silver Sand, Marwad, Nani Daman.	Vehicle Parking Zone.

Further, in exercise of powers conferred under Section 116 of Motor Vehicle Act, I hereby authorize the Executive Engineer, PWD, Daman for erection of traffic sign board mentioned above for the purpose of regulating Motor Vehicle Traffic.

In case of violation of above, violating vehicles will be impounded and shall be released on payment of prescribed penalty.

This Notification shall come into force from 6.00 p.m. on 31/12/2013 and will remain in force till 2.00 hours of 01/01/2014.



CIRCULAR

On the eve of New Year, celebrations are being organized at various places in Daman, This year also on 31st December, 2013 in view of the said celebrations, all the Hoteliers, Bar and Restaurant Owners are directed to strictly adhere to the following instructions and guidelines.

1. All the Hotel Owners and Bar and Restaurant Owners are directed to restrict their Guests within their premises and should under no circumstances allow them to go out on the open street or road in inebriated state.
2. The celebration should be confined to the hotel/bar/restaurant premises only. For running orchestra/musical evening, **temporary permission shall be taken from the office of Collector/District Magistrate well in advance i.e. before 27-12-2013**, failing which, Police will be taking appropriate action for creating nuisance in terms of noise/Sound Pollution.
3. No liquor should be served outside the licensed premises.
4. All bars and Restaurants who have obtained special permission should be closed by 02-00 hours of 1st January, 2014 and others by normal closing hours i.e. 11.00 p.m. on 31/12/2013.
5. Each Hotel must set up "**Lost and Found counter**" along with Public Address System (PAS) and bring any information regarding loss of any property immediately to the knowledge of the public through the PAS. In case nobody claims the lost property, information may immediately be sent to the Police Control Room (**Telephone No.2220102/ 2220444**).
6. All unclaimed property should be sent to the Police Station by 4.00 p.m. on 01/01/2014.
7. No vehicle should be allowed to enter the No Parking Zone or go anywhere near the beaches.
8. No. vehicle will play in "**Restricted Zone**" without Vehicle Pass issued by the Sub Divisional Police Officer, Daman. Passes may be collected by 6.00 p.m. on 29/12/2013 from the office of Sub Divisional Police Officer, Daman.
9. Full Assistance should be provided to the Government Officers on duty in maintaining Law & Order.
10. Failure to observe the above instructions shall lead to stringent penal action




